About the project:

The project "Under the loupe: Rural Youth Work!" is a 15 months project involving partners from Serbia, Croatia and Slovenia - NAPOR, Prizma, Idrija2020, and two research institutes: Institut drustvenih nauka and Institut drustvenih znanosti "Ivo Pilar" with the aim to explore Rural Youth Work. About Webinars:

Webinars will be organized as part of public awareness campaign named Let's go Rural! The idea of these part of campaign is to hear perspective of Rural Youth presented in the form of 3 webinars where at least 60 young people from different rural environments of the partner countries will gather to discuss their realities and needs.

Working language will be English but <u>that will not be a selection criterion</u>. For participants who do not speak or understand English **support will be provided**.

What young participants will get through these Webinars:

- the chance to meet their peers from Serbia, Croatia and Sovenia,
- the chance to exchange their views and ideas,
- the chance to have their voices heard,
- the chance that their ideas and feedback will be used for enhancing the situation of young people in the rural areas.

Participant profile:

- 15 to 30 years old;
- Residents in the rural areas in Republic Slovenia, Croatia or Serbia;
- Motivated to participate in three webinars in September;
- Motivated to speak about needs of rural youth;
- Open to explore and use different online methods and tools.

Obligations of participants:

The participants of webinars are expected to be actively involved in following activities:

- Active participation during three webinars in September on ZOOM (one webinar per week);
- Filling evaluation form.

Selection process of participants:

All interested young people, who meet the above criteria, can apply by filling <u>online application</u> <u>form</u> no later than August 31st 2020, by 5.00 PM.
